We act as a hub and resource between caregivers, patients, and medical teams.




### What is Shared Living?

Shared Living is one option in a range of housing and support services for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities and/or Autism that allows an individual to live in a family-style setting and become a member of the household that functions as a family. Within this option, there are two styles to choose consider:

1. A home owned, leased, or rented by the individual, where care and support are directly provided to/for the individual.
2. The individual is incorporated into a family in a residence owned, leased, or rented by the family.



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### What are Home Support Services?

Whether you decide to receive care in a private home or an agency-managed apartment setting, our direct support professionals (DSPs) will carefully and expertly coordinate care based on the individual's needs. Each of our services are scheduled throughout the week in pre-determined blocks of time.

Our residential group homes are staffed up to 24 hours a day and designed to support various levels and types of needs. Services include support across medical, dietary, and behavioral needs that are carefully identified and added into their person-centered plan (PCP).

All services are accomplished according to the PCP, which allows for a small amount of flexibility and individual preference. While there are many services to choose from, they fall into three categories:

1. Daily living activities
2. Self-care and self-management
3. Personal development and well-being
